**TECHNICAL CHANGES GRANTED**

ON BRACEBRIDGE 102.3 CIIG Move to 98.3. Increase power from 32 to 50 watts.  
 ON MARKHAM 105.9 CFMS Decrease power from 981 to 630 watts (increase Max. ERP from 2,500 to 3,000 watts). Raise antenna height. Relocate transmitter.  
 ON MISSISSAUGA 960 CKNT-cp Relocate transmitter. Power will remain 2,000 watts (days) / 280 watts (nights).  
 ON TIMMINS 97.1 CBON-25 Decrease power from 41,000 to 11,000 watts. Raise antenna height. Relocate transmitter.  
 QC MONT LAURIER 91.1 CBFX-6 Increase power from 72,000 to 83,800 watts. Lower antenna height.  
 QC MONT LAURIER 91.9 CBF-9 Increase power from 38,000 to 40,430 watts. Lower antenna height.

**EXTENSIONS TO CP's GRANTED**

ON BOLTON 105.5 CJFB Vista Radio has until April 15, 2019 to relocate to this station to 102.7 and increase power from 50 to 1,100 watts.  
 ON WINDSOR 90.5 CJAH-cp United Christian Broadcasters has until December 3, 2018 to get this 10,000 watt Christian station on the air.  
 QC LABEL-SUR-QUEVILLON 97.9 CKCJ-cp Le Son du 49 has until January 30, 2019 to get this 50 watt French language Community station on the air.

**DENIALS**

BC VANCOUVER 104.3 CHLG Remove condition of license which states that 15% of the music broadcast on the station consist of Category 3 (blues, jazz, & folk). The CRTC felt that the applicant has not demonstrated a compelling economic need for the amendment.

 SK REGINA 107.9 Non-Commercial. 100,000 watts. Christian. United Christian Broadcasters.

ON SAVANT LAKE 104.9 CBQL Increase power from 78 to 135 watts. Lower antenna height. Relocate transmitter.  
 ON TORONTO 88.1 CIND Increase power from 2,100 to 4,700 watts (4,000 to 13,000 watts Max. ERP). Raise antenna height.

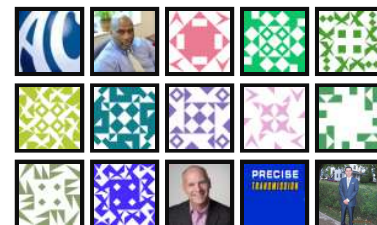
